What's Cooking?

Lychee and Pomegranate Pannacotta

Makes 14 Cups

1 can Lychee in syrup4 and half tsp gelatin1 cup heavy cream/200ml

2 cups whole milk

1/2 cup caster sugar



*Process lychees in food processor, strain to get 1 and 1/2 cup.

*Melt gelatin in double boiler.

*Combine lychee liquid,cream,milk and sugar in a med sauce pan. Heat on medium till sugar dissolves.

*Remove from heat, add gelatin, divide into cups and refrigerate to set, at least for 2 hours.

2 cups Pomegranate juice

4 tsp gelatin

Sugar to taste

Melt gelatin in double boiler and cool a bit.mix in Pomegranate juice.

*Pour on the already set lychee layer.

*Refridgerate for another 2 hours.
